

Barefoot Bowls @ The Creek

HOW TO PLAY

- You place the white/yellow mat on the line
- Jack is the small white/yellow bowl that you're trying to get as close to as possible
- You roll the jack down the green. Once it has stopped you then place it on the line
- Always have the little sticker on the inside to which way you want the bowl to turn
- The bowl should always be positioned in the middle of your hand
- Have both feet together on the mat and then step off with your left foot for right hand bowlers (**left hand bowlers step off with their right foot**)
- Have both feet aiming towards the yellow/white boundary pegs of the rink. This will ensure the bowl will turn back towards the jack
- If your bowls goes in the gutter/ditch without touching the jack it's a dead bowl. Bowl is to be taken off the green. The only time your bowl remains in the gutter/ditch is when it has touched the jack
- Rink – the section of the green which a game is played on
- Toucher – when the bowl delivered has come into contact with the jack

RULES AND HOW TO SCORE

- All bowls must remain inside the boundary pegs of your rink or are removed from the green
- A bowl that goes into the ditch without touching the jack is removed from the green
- Teams bowl alternately as a team
